

#### AFFIRMATION OF BAPTISM - CONFIRMATION

- P: I now call forward our Ninth Grade Confirmands to affirm the faith of the church and be confirmed. (Confirmands will come forward)
- P: Trinity Elizabeth Davis, Tyson Thomas Davis and Levi Michael Hunter, is it your desire to affirm the faith of the church, affirm your baptism and be confirmed, if so answer, "It is!"

Confirmands: It is!

P: Let us pray. Merciful God, we thank you for Trinity, Tyson and Levi, whom you have made your own by water and the Word in Holy Baptism. You have called them to yourself, enlightened them with the gifts of your Spirit, and nourished them in the community of faith. Uphold them in the gifts and promises of Holy Baptism, and unite the hearts of all whom you have brought to new birth. We ask this in the name of Christ. **Amen.** 

#### PROFESSION OF FAITH

P: I ask you, Trinity, Tyson and Levi to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church.

Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God? If so answer, "I renounce them."

Confirmands: I renounce them.

P: Do you renounce the powers of this world that rebel against God? If so answer, "I renounce them." Confirmands: I renounce them.

P: Do you renounce the ways of sin that draw you from God? If so answer, "I renounce them."

Confirmands: I renounce them.

The presiding minister addresses the candidates and the assembly.

The creed is spoken along with the entire congregation.

Do you believe in God the Father?

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead.\*

On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.

#### **AFFIRMATION**

P: People of God, do you promise to support and pray for Trinity, Tyson and Levi in their new life in Christ? If so, answer "We do, and we ask God to help and guide us."

C: We do, and we ask God to help and guide us.

Confirmands will kneel at the communion rail, their confirmation verses will be read and the prayer will be prayed over each one of them.

Trinity Elizabeth Davis has chosen as her Confirmation Verse Joshua 1:9

I hereby command you: Be strong and courageous; do not be frightened or dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

Tyson Thomas Davis has chosen as his Confirmation Verse Matthew 5:16

In the same way, let your light shine before others,
so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.

Levi Michael Hunter has chosen as his Confirmation Verse Joshua 24:15

Now if you are unwilling to serve the LORD, choose this day whom you will serve,
whether the gods your ancestors served in the region beyond the River or the gods of the Amorites
in whose land you are living; but as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD."

The laying on of hands and the praying of this prayer is prayed upon each Confirmand.

<sup>22</sup>We know that the whole creation has been groaning in labor pains until now; <sup>23</sup>and not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly while we wait for adoption, the redemption of our bodies. <sup>24</sup>For in hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what is seen? <sup>25</sup>But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience. <sup>26</sup>Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but that very Spirit intercedes with sighs too deep for words. <sup>27</sup>And God, who searches the heart, knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.





as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.




